DEFINITIONS

SOUTH-EAST QUEENSLAND AREA - The area comprising the following:-

- (a) the Sunshine Coast Area;
- (b) the area east of the Bruce Highway between the existing Sunshine Coast Area and the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (c) the area occupied by non-exempt shops fronting onto the western side of the Bruce Highway between the existing Sunshine Coast Area and the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (d) the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (e) the local government area for the Gold Coast City Council that is not included in the Brisbane Statistical Division;
- (f) the islands in the coastal waters of the State east of the areas mentioned in (a) to (e) that are not included in the Brisbane Statistical Division.
- (g) The area within the following boundaries: Commencing from the point where the Bruce Highway intersects with Bells Creek Road; from that point following a line due west until the line intersects with Old Gympie Road; from that point following a direct line to the point where the Bruce Highway intersects with Red Road; from that point in a northerly direction along the Bruce Highway to the point of commencement.

Brisbane Statistical Division - Shall mean the Brisbane Statistical Division defined in the 2001 edition of the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (Cat. No. 1216.0) published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

Provided that for the purposes of trading on Saturdays this definitions excludes the islands as defined in clause (5) of Schedule 1.

INNER CITY OF BRISBANE – The area within the following boundaries:-

Commencing at the centre of the William Jolly Bridge; thence along such bridge north to Skew Street; thence along Skew Street to Saul Street; thence along Saul Street to Countess Street; thence along Countess Street to Kelvin Grove Road; thence along Kelvin Grove Road to Ithaca Street; thence along Ithaca Street to Gilchrist Avenue; thence along Gilchrist Avenue to Bowen Bridge Road; thence along Bowen Bridge Road to the centre of Bowen Bridge; thence along the midstream of Enoggera Creek to Breakfast Creek; thence along the midstream of Breakfast Creek to the Brisbane River; and thence along the midstream of such river to the point of commencement at the centre of the William Jolly Bridge:

Provided that where the boundary of such part of the Inner City of Brisbane is a street, road or avenue, shops on both sides of the street, road or avenue, shall be regarded as being within such part:

AREA OF CITY HEART OF INNER CITY OF BRISBANE - The area within the following boundaries:-

Commencing at the outer extremities of the junction of Edward Street and Alice Street; thence along Alice Street to its junction with William Street and North Quay; thence along William Street and North Quay to its junction with Makerston Street; thence along Makerston Street to its junction with Roma Street; thence along Roma Street to its junction with Albert Street; thence along Albert Street to its junction with Wickham Terrace; thence along Wickham Terrace to its junction with Turbot Street; thence along Turbot Street to its junction with Wharf Street; thence along Wharf Street to its junction with Eagle Street; thence along Eagle Street to its junction with Mary Street; thence along Mary Street to its junction with Felix Street; thence along Felix Street to its junction with Margaret Street; thence along Margaret Street to its junction with Edward Street; thence along Edward Street to its junction with Alice Street:

Provided that any premises facing onto any of the named streets shall be deemed to be within the defined area.”.

AREA OF NEW FARM OF INNER CITY OF BRISBANE

That area as bound by the Brisbane River to the East, South and West, and to the North by a line connecting the River to Harcourt Street to Commercial Road and following Commercial Road North-East to the River.

THE WOOLLOONGABBA CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT - The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Wellington Road and Stanley Street; then along Stanley Street to Annerley Road; then along Annerley Road to Catherine Street; then along Catherine Street to Merton Street; then along Merton Street to Hawthorne Street; then along Hawthorne Street to Ipswich Road; then along Ipswich Road to Balaclava Street; then along Balaclava Street to Wellington Road; then along Wellington Road to its junction with Stanley Street:

Provided that any premises facing onto any of the named streets shall be deemed to be within the defined area.

TOURIST AND/OR SEASIDE RESORTS - Rainbow Beach; Tin Can Bay; Burrum Heads; Woodgate; Elliott Heads; Bargara; Moore Park; Keppel Sands; Emu Park; and the islands off the sea coast of Queensland being part of the State of Queensland.

Provided that for the purposes of trading on Sundays and Public Holidays this definition excludes the islands as defined in clause (1) of Schedule 1.

GOLD COAST AREA – That part of the eastern portion of the State within the following boundaries:–

Commencing at the junction of the sea coast and the southern bank of the Coomera River thence along the southern bank of that river to its junction with Coombabah Creek; thence by the southern bank of that creek to the Gold Coast Highway; thence westerly along the Gold Coast Highway to its junction with the Pacific Highway; thence by a straight line to the point on the Nerang River situated 1 kilometre in a direct line westerly from the nearest point on the western boundary of the Pacific Highway; thence by a line parallel to, and one kilometre to the west of, the western boundary of the Pacific Highway to the intersection of that line with the Tallebudgera Creek Road; thence by a straight line to a point on the Queensland – New South Wales border situated 6 kilometres in a direct line from the sea coast at its nearest point; thence by that border to its junction with the sea coast; thence by the sea coast to the point of commencement.

SUNSHINE COAST AREA – The area within the following boundaries:–

Commencing at the far north point of Noosa Heads then following the coast line west, to the Noosa River, following the river to its junction with Wooroi Creek, then following Wooroi Creek to its junction with McKinnon Drive, then following that road east to its junction with Butler Street, then following Butler Street south west (the road becoming Cooroy-Noosa Road) until its junction with Beckhams Road, following that road to its junction with the Eumundi Noosa Road, then following that road to its junction with Fellowship Drive, then in a straight line south to Nambour-Bli Bli Road, then following that road west (the road becoming Bli Bli Road, National Park Road, Netherton Street, Blackall Terrace and Mapleton Road) to the junction of Mapleton Road and Carter Road, then following Carter Road to its junction with Arundell Avenue, then following Arundell Avenue to its junction with Lamington Terrace, then following Lamington Terrace in a south-easterly direction until it becomes the Nambour Connection Road, then following the Nambour Connection Road in a southerly direction to its junction with the Bruce Highway, then following the Bruce Highway in a southerly direction to its junction with the Sunshine Motorway, then following the Sunshine Motorway east to its junction with Military Road, then in a straight line south to Bells Creek, then following that creek to the Pumicestone Channel; and
The suburb of Maleny.

CAIRNS TOURIST AREA – The area within the following boundaries:–

Commencing at a line due west from the Sea Coast to the junction of Jensen and Montrose Streets, then a line due south to the junction of Laurel Avenue and Hardy Road, then a line due east to the sea coast; and

Commencing from the township of Ellis Beach where it is located on the Captain Cook Highway, then following the Captain Cook Highway in a southerly direction to the point where the Captain Cook Highway crosses the Barron River, then following the Barron River in an easterly direction to the sea coast, then following the sea coast in a northerly direction to the point of commencement (viz the township of Ellis Beach where it is located on the sea coast); and

Commencing from the junction of the Captain Cook Highway and Stanton Road, west along Stanton Road to the junction of Stanton Road and Upper Stanton Road, then a line due south to the Kennedy Highway, then east along the Kennedy Highway to the junction with the Captain Cook Highway then north along the Captain Cook Highway to the point of commencement.

TOWNSVILLE TOURIST AREA – The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Morris Street and Flinders Street; thence along Flinders Street to Bridge Street; thence by Bridge Street to the railway line; thence by the railway line to its junction with Ross Creek; thence by the northern bank of that creek to a point in a direct line with the Strand; thence along the Strand to its junction with Howitt Street; thence along Howitt Street to its junction with Warburton Street; thence in a southerly direction along Warburton, Eyre, Oxley and Denham Streets to the junction of Denham Street and Wills Street; thence along Wills Street to its junction with Blackwood Street; thence along Blackwood Street to its junction with Walker Street; thence along Walker Street to its junction with Morris Street; thence along Morris Street to its junction with Flinders Street:

Provided that any premises facing onto any of the named streets shall be deemed to be within the defined area.

Note: The Townsville Tourist Area includes the area known as The Townsville Central Business District – The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Morris Street and Flinders Street; then along Flinders Street to Bridge Street; then by Bridge Street to the Railway Line; then by the Railway Line to its junction with Ross Creek; then by the Northern Bank of that creek to a point in a direct line with the Strand; then along the Strand to its junction with Melton Terrace; then along Melton Terrace to its junction with Denham Street; then along Denham Street to its junction with Wills Street; then along Wills Street to its junction with Blackwood Street; then along Blackwood Street to its junction with Walker Street; then along Walker Street to its junction with Morris Street; then along Morris Street to its junction with Flinders Street.

TOWNSVILLE AND THURINGOWA AREA (excluding the Townsville Tourist Area)

The local authority areas of the cities of Townsville and Thuringowa excluding the Townsville Tourist Area as defined in “The Townsville Tourist Area”.

DOUGLAS SHIRE TOURIST AREA – The area within the following boundaries:-

Commencing at the sea coast and by Port Street running along Davidson Street in front of the Marina Mirage to the intersection with Port Douglas Road, and from that intersection to Four Mile Beach bounded by the eastern boundary of the Golf Course.

WHITSUNDAY SHIRE TOURIST AREA - The area within the following boundaries:-

Commencing at the junction of Coconut and Shute Harbour Road. Then due east to the shoreline of Boat Haven proceeding along the foreshore in a northerly and then westerly direction to the mouth of Galbraith Creek. Then south along Galbraith Creek to the junction of Galbraith Creek and Shute Harbour Road. Then in a line of a north easterly direction to the eastern end of Tropic Road, then to the eastern most end of Eshelby Drive, then to the junction of Orana Street and Waterson Road. Then proceeding in a line back to the junction of Coconut Drive and Shute Harbour Road crossing the intersection of Harper Street and Golden Orchard Drive.

HERVEY BAY AREA – The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing from the point where Shore Road meets the sea coast; then by a line due West to the Maryborough-Hervey Bay Road; then by a line to the point on the sea coast where Eli Creek enters the sea; and then by the sea coast to the point of commencement.

THE ROCKHAMPTON CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT - The area bounded by the Fitzroy River, North Street, George Street and Stanley Street.

THE YEPPON TOURIST AREA - The area within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the junction of Anzac Parade and John Street; then along John Street in a westerly direction to its junction with Park Street; then along Park Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Tanby and Rockhampton Roads; then along Rockhampton Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Birdwood Avenue; then in a straight line to the junction of Shadow Brook Place and Caroline Street; then following a straight line due east to Farnborough Road; then along Farnborough Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Anzac Parade; then along Anzac Parade to the point of commencement.
